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The Matteson Public Library in Matteson, Illinois, completed a major expansion this Fall; and we were proud to be a part of it. Kathy Berggren, the Library Director, stated that some of the new features of the renovated library are:

“When checking out Matteson library items, patrons have the choice of using one of the new self-check kiosks or asking a staff member to check the items out for them.

We now have:

- an automated book return that dispenses receipts
- the ability to convert your personal VHS tapes to DVDs
- two types of phone apps – BookMyne for catalog access or Boopsie for catalog and web access
- Lynda.com – a database of professional development and technology skills videos
- Freegal – allows you to download or stream music at home
- Brainfuse – replacing tutor.com. This is a one-on-one online tutoring service for homework assistance
- Passport registration – renewal forms are available in the office but for new applications contact the office for assistance
- Authors On Demand – Adult Services staff will arrange to automatically place a hold for a Matteson library cardholder on a print edition of their favorite author’s newest titles.”

The library chose three “E” series D-Tech Kiosks for self-checkout, one for the children’s library and two for the main lobby in front of the circulation desk. The two kiosks in the lobby accept credit cards using PCI complaint credit card terminals, which allows patrons to pay fine and fees; while the children’s self-checkout kiosk accepts coins and bills, as well as give change and receipts. “D-Tech even let us pick out custom powder coat colors,” said Ms. Berggren, “that matched our multicolored walls!”



D-Tech’s Plexiglas security gates provide material security. The LED lights illuminates red when unauthorized material is attempted to be removed from the library, and an alarm goes off as well. Our GateViewer software identifies the items by name and barcode. Mr. Erwin noted that our “GateViewer software comes in handy when a mother with a stack of books sets off an alarm

because one of her children may have placed a book on the stack without her knowing after the other books were checked-out. It really avoids a lot of hassle in looking for the book that has set off the alarm.”

The new automated material handling system gives receipts to patrons and speeds the shelving of materials, plus D-Tech’s RFID system even turns the security chip back on automatically saving staff time. D-Tech’s automated book returns are ADA compliant as are their security gates.
